

GRANTS FOR LAMBETH YOUNG PEOPLE WITH EXCEPTIONAL TALENT OR SPECIAL NEEDS



Grant Announcement April 2010

The Walcot Foundation is pleased to announce the availability of grants for low-income Lambeth residents under age 30 who possess exceptional talent or have special needs (or both).

These grants aim to help financially disadvantaged Lambeth young people pursue leisure time activities in which they have demonstrated exceptional talent or which would provide a particular educational benefit.

Grants awarded under this programme have included -

- support for involvement in music, the arts or sport
- musical instruments
- course fees
- competition expenses
- special clothing
- extra-curricular study
- educational travel
- ICT equipment

but new and creative ideas are most welcome.

These grants can be up to **£2000 per year** (most are not as high as this). Award amounts very much depend on the financial circumstances of the applicant and the requirements of the activity. A thorough financial assessment is carried out.

An interview (either in person or by telephone) may be required.
