<i>Organisation</i>	198 Contemporary Arts and Learning		
<p>198 is a venue for the exhibition of visual arts, a community hub and an arts education space. The organisation has grown from a community arts space, which helped nurture the Black Arts movement, into a contemporary visual arts organisation searching out artistic excellence and investing in emerging talents with a particular focus on supporting the development of emerging artists and young creatives. 198 work with local young people aged 16-30 from disadvantaged backgrounds offering creative skills development, employability support and IAG and provides opportunities to reconnect with learning, work towards careers in the creative and cultural industries and have a voice on issues that are important to them.</p>			
<i>Project</i>	The Factory: Fast Forward into the Creative and Cultural Industries		
<p>Fast Forward will support individuals with some creative experience into careers in the creative and cultural industries, with a particular focus on art/design. They will offer two six-month intakes per year with the opportunity to increase and refresh skills, enhance networks and gain work experience. The project will take place at the newly refurbished 198's gallery and will include access to their new facilities, including gallery space, Mac suite and learning/shadowing with other creatives who have taken up residence there.</p>

<i>Organisation</i>	Construction Youth Trust		
<p>Construction Youth Trust aim is to inspire and enable young people to overcome barriers and discover a career in the construction and built environment sector. The trust was established by leaders of the construction industry and allied professions, and supports young people to recognise their full potential and help them to discover fulfilling and robust careers within the industry.</p>			
<i>Project</i>	Bridging the gap to construction employment		
<p>Support for unemployed under 16-30 year olds interested in construction as a career via a programme of one-to-one coaching, training, employer-led work experiences and employability work. The project will also focus on getting participants 'work ready' and then connecting them with real employment and training opportunities in the industry.</p>

<i>Organisation</i>	Creative Sparkworks and Iconic Steps		
<p>Creative Sparkworks is a community-based educational, training and employment media & arts charity. They work with young people from under-represented groups aged 18 to 30, delivering free accredited film and employment skills training with paid work placements and ongoing links to industry employers. Their trainees also work on paid public commissions such as documenting the Lambeth Country Show via Lambeth Walk Films, their peer production unit.</p> <p>Iconic Steps is a social enterprise that supports young people (aged 16-25) from diverse and underrepresented backgrounds to enter the media industry. They champion a holistic approach to each young person's development, so in addition to industry specific training, mentoring and practical</p>			

experience on 'real projects', their beneficiaries attend workshops in related life-skills including resilience, personal finance and CV writing. Iconic Steps also create fresh and engaging content commissioned by clients, through working with their commercial team of young people.			
<i>Project</i>	Steps and Sparks to Work		
A partnership between project that will help low-income Lambeth residents gain access to the film and media industry. This will include hands-on technical craft and software training, 1-2-1 employability skills coaching, soft skills and wellbeing support, motivational industry speakers and mentoring. Drawing on a strong network of employers within film and TV industry the project will also connect trainees to entry level jobs in the sector and offer ongoing peer-led support to help ensure a high retention of jobs and progression in the industry.

<i>Organisation</i>	Groundwork London		
Groundwork is a federation of charities mobilising practical community action on poverty and the environment across the UK. Groundwork do this by helping create better places to live, improving peoples' prospects and promoting greener choices.			
<i>Project</i>	BounceBack to Rework		
A salaried work placement programme for those with more significant barriers to employment. Participants taking part will receive 6 months mentoring and confidence building sessions whilst also developing new practical and technical skills to help them gain long term employment in new green industries. Placements will be based at Groundwork's workshop in Wandsworth, repairing scrapped domestic appliances and furniture. After 6 months trainees will either be retained permanently at Rework, offered suitable employment elsewhere within Groundwork or supported to find other opportunities.

Today, High Trees delivers a range of integrated services to connect people and communities to strengthen skills and build stronger voices.

The project will provide a 1:1 job searching service, access to in-house vocational courses/training and links to employment opportunities via High Tree's sector-based work academies.

<i>Organisation</i>	Indoamerican Refugee and Migrant Organisation (IRMO)		
IRMO is a community-led organisation providing Latin American migrants and other Spanish and Portuguese speakers with tools and information to build secure, independent, and integrated lives in the UK. The LA community is one of the fastest growing, yet least visible, migrant communities in London and IRMO's work spans three main 'pillars': Education, training and employment; Advice and case-work; and Children and young people. IRMO also have a cross-cutting pillar - campaigning for migrants' rights.			
<i>Project</i>	Supporting young Latin Americans out of the pandemic and into work		
Project supporting Latin American migrants and other Spanish and Portuguese speaking Lambeth residents under the age of 30 into employment. The project will include 1:1 job searching support, access to ESOL classes, employability workshops, training and certifications (e.g. CSCS cards) and ongoing support to retain jobs once secured.

<i>Organisation</i>	Lambeth College		
Lambeth College exists to meet the needs of those that live, work and learn in Lambeth, providing access to lifelong learning for young low-income people. Lambeth College offers a wide range of high-quality courses and apprenticeships that will open the door to future career opportunities to Lambeth residents. The aim is to support Lambeth residents to become a qualified, work ready and motivated professionals with the skills and confidence to participate in today's competitive job market.			
<i>Project</i>	Raising Incomes for Young Lambeth Residents		
The project will provide training, employability support and access to education alongside the College's Youth Hub and youth work team, engaging many more under 30s than current capacity allows, with a particular focus on 21+ age range. The project will connect local unemployed people to all the opportunities on offer at the college (such as their sector-based work academies and work experience) and also offer 1:1 sessions and support to those who need it.

<i>Organisation</i>	Leadership Through Sport and Business		
Leadership Through Sport and Business (LTSB) is a social mobility charity supporting low-income young people (aged 16-24) who have faced disadvantage into sustainable employment. LTSB use an intensive approach including skills bootcamps, networking and professional development opportunities, one-to-one support, professional mentoring, support into paid apprenticeships, diversity and inclusion training for employers, and ongoing pastoral care during employment. LTSB aim to equip the young people with the skills, opportunities <i>and</i> support they need to overcome their challenges, secure and sustain employment, and lift themselves out of poverty.			
<i>Project</i>	More Than An Apprentice, Lambeth		
Support for young people to gain paid apprenticeships via specialist employability 'bootcamps'. Each bootcamp is between 1 month and 4 months long (depending on the sector) and participants will gain employability skills and qualifications needed to transition into employment in the finance, legal, and digital sectors upon completion. Participants can be supported into paid roles with partner employers.

<i>Organisation</i>	Rathbone		
Rathbone provides social, recreational, welfare and education activities to adults with a learning disability and children and young people with a learning disability and other disadvantaged children and young people. Rathbone promote independence and life skills, support people to try new things, and create opportunities for people to come together with the aim that 'Young people are able to make informed choices that enable them to reach their individual potential and lead fulfilling lives'.			
<i>Project</i>	Education and Employment Programme		
This project will provide casework support, small group sessions and employment brokerage to young people aged 18-30 who <i>need</i> additional help to access the jobs market. The project will work alongside the Rathbone Youth Hub and offer a wider range of support services as well as referrals to the Job Centre/Youth Hub opportunities when participants are 'job ready'.

<i>Organisation</i>	Ripe Learning		
Ripe Learning tackle language, numeracy, digital and essential skills via a 'hub & spoke' satellite delivery model by taking learning to community hubs across London. Ripe Learning offer classes and online learning in order to provide individuals with the skills necessary to progress into jobs, help their families. Ripe Learning work collaboratively with housing associations, employers and grass roots community and voluntary organisations.			
<i>Project</i>	Better Skills, <i>Better Jobs</i>		
A programme to improve the Digital, English, Maths and Employability skills of participants, with a focus on engaging BAME groups and parents. Learners will work towards Entry Level to Level 2 qualifications to meet the necessary entry requirements for a range of job roles primarily within the Digital, Health and Social Care sectors with employability sessions embedded in all aspects of teaching/learning.

Slade Gardens has an adventure playground, garden and early years centre which offers over an acre of safe, staffed space where children & young people can come to play, make new friends, develop skills & try new things. They are open to children of every background between the ages of 6 – 16.			
<i>Project</i>	Lambeth Play and Early Years Training for Employment		
This project will train local residents to take up professional posts as Play Workers, Early Years Workers and Gardeners. Participants will gain AQA qualifications in their chosen area and complete work experience at Slade Gardens, which will offer 3-month in-house work placements in all 3 specialisms. Upon completion, participants will be supported to find employment in their chosen industry and some will be offered work at Slade as part of their expanded holiday programmes.

Spiral will offer 1:1 coaching, skills development and training to unemployed under 30's. They will be taking referrals as well as supporting their alumni from their school programmes. Participants will be offered a range of work experience and work taster events through Spiral's extensive list of partner businesses and also be linked in with employment opportunities.

<i>Project</i>	Lambeth Under 30s Employment and Support		
Thames Reach will employ a Lambeth Jobs Broker to help under 30's who are struggling to access the job market. The Job Broker will support clients to become work ready and source suitable employment opportunities locally via their existing networks. Clients that require more basic skills development (or specific qualifications/certification) can be referred to Thames Reach interlinked employment and skills services. This project will take referrals from a network of supported housing and homelessness services across the borough, which Thames Reach run, as well as other general referrals.

Toucan's service is tailored to meet both the needs of the job-seeker and the employer by offering full support during the whole of the recruitment process.

A catering sector-specific project, run in collaboration with Kata Kata Restaurant, Cafe Van Gogh, and The Old Post Office Bakery in order to develop the employability skills of participants with disabilities and learning difficulties. Work experience, certified training and soft skills development will be on offer to participants interested in pursuing a career in catering/hospitality as well as intensive job search support.

<p>Unity Works is a specialist organisation supporting people with a learning disability to gain skills, achieve qualifications and secure jobs, so they can reach their full potential. They support people to become more confident and improve their physical and mental health so they can live truly independent lives and take steps towards employment.</p>			
<i>Project</i>	Unity Lambeth		
<p>Under 30's with a learning disability will be supported by a Lambeth. Each individual will work with a specialist Employment Advisor in order to help them identify and apply for jobs that interest them. They will be able to access one-to-one sessions and small group employability courses and have the opportunity to acquire NVQ accreditations in catering, hospitality or warehouse management and complete training placements in one of Unity Work's seven social enterprises in London. These activities will be complemented by a wider Health and Wellbeing Programme, which offers discussion groups, health and fitness and social opportunities. Once people are at a point where they feel ready, they will have access to a London-wide Jobs Broker, who can help move 'job ready' participants into roles and support them when in post.</p>

<p>Walworth Garden is a charity dedicated to knowledge and nurture. Their aim is to improve lives by providing excellent learning and horticultural therapy through an award-winning garden that is open to all. Walworth Garden serves the community that built it and equip the community with environmental awareness and practical skills through accessible, accredited horticultural training courses, educational weekend workshops, therapeutic horticulture groups, and regular volunteering sessions - all free to local residents.</p>			
<i>Project</i>	Level 2 Work-Based Horticulture		
<p>A work-based horticulture training programme for unemployed Lambeth residents who face more significant barriers to employment. Walworth Gardens consists of a working garden/farm, plant shop and horticulture business that is able to train and offer work experience to those with an interest in gardening/horticulture but no previous experience. Participants will gain a City and Guilds qualification, be given appropriate work wear, paid work experience and the possibility of employment with the business arm upon completion of studies. Graduates who are not taken on by Walworth are given support to access other employment in the sector.</p>
